



## Multi-Sectoral Advisory Group Meeting Friday 29 November 2024, 11.00-12.00

This first advisory group meeting introduced the project, team and advisors. Dr Gill Buck shared the vision and overall plan for the study, which is summarised <u>here</u>.

Team members introduced themselves, their roles on the project and some of their 'superpowers', which were discovered with the help of Dr Emma Murray at our team induction. Thinking about ourselves as superheroes with key skills was a fun way of sharing what skills and strengths we bring to this work.

Advisory group members then introduced themselves, their interests in the work, what they bring to the advisor role and their own 'superpowers'! It was great to hear the range of powers shared from *deconstructing*, *gathering obscure histories*, *seeing systems*, *and providing solidarity*, *to slowing down*, *thinking critically*, *reflecting*, *mixing*, *listening* and *connecting*.

The team next posed some questions for advisors to consider for these early stages, including:

- What ideas, advice or resources do you have for supporting the safe recruitment and management of lived experience advisory boards?
- Can you signpost any interesting written histories of lived experience in criminal justice?
- Can you suggest any lived experience based criminal justice projects in England, Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland or Ireland that could make a good case study?
